

Murwillumbah East Public School upgrade

Works notification | 19 June 2025

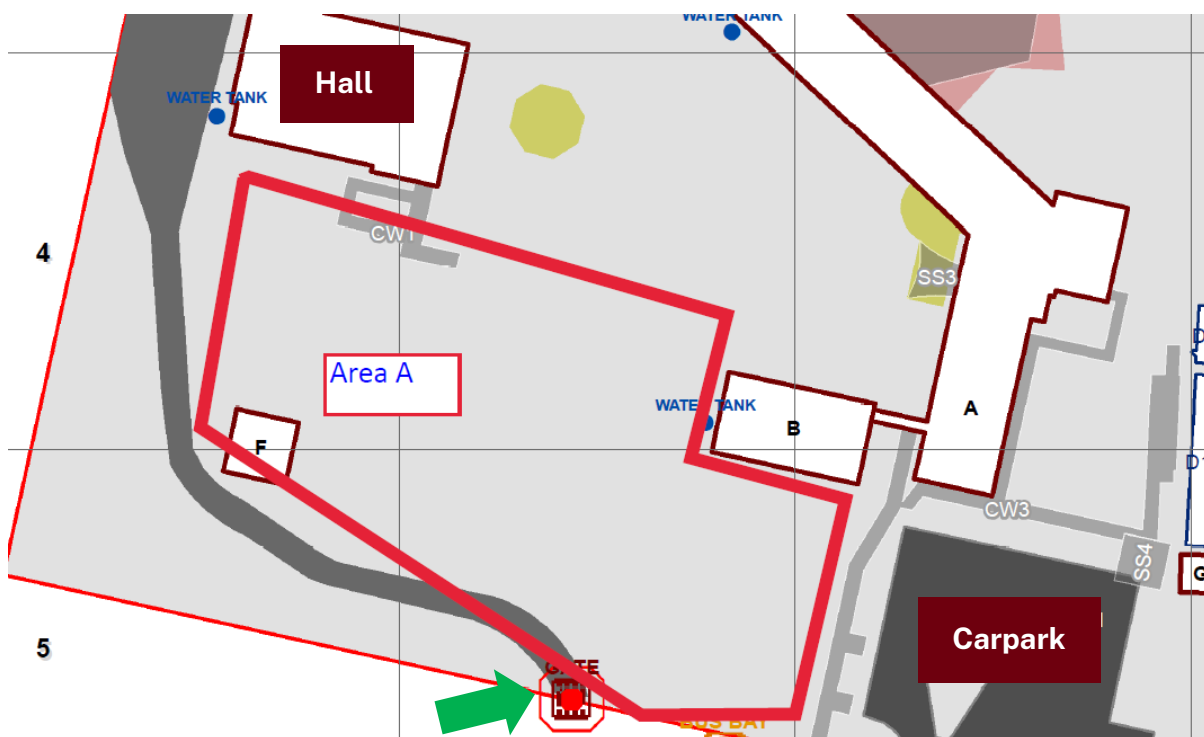
Planning is underway for the construction of new permanent, flood resilient facilities at Murwillumbah East Public School. The project will provide new classrooms, a canteen and facilities for specialist support classes. The project will also enable all demountable buildings to be removed from the school.

Geotechnical investigations and soil testing

From **Monday 24 June 2025 to Friday 27 June 2025** (weather permitting) contractors will be onsite at Murwillumbah East Public School conducting geotechnical investigations to assess the subsurface soil and rock conditions and taking soil samples for testing.

Work will take place between **7:30 am and 6 pm** and will involve the use of drilling rigs to dig boreholes and test pits. There will be some sound from the drill rig motors during this work.

An exclusion zone will be created around the work area (shown as 'Area A' in the map below) to ensure student, staff and visitor safety. Trucks will enter from George Street (refer to green arrow below) and we will work closely with the contractor to maintain safety and minimise any impact on school operations, neighbours and local traffic.
