

Murwillumbah Learning Community High School

Works notification | June 2023

During the Term 2 school holiday period and into Term 3, School Infrastructure NSW (SINSW) will be doing some work at and around the Wollumbin High School site.

This work will enhance pedestrian safety and provide more appropriate interim spaces for staff and the front office while the combined high school remains at the site. The NSW Government remains committed to delivering two separate high schools in Murwillumbah after a consultation with the school community.

Road and footpath works

To enhance road and pedestrian safety around the school entrance, SINSW has approval from Tweed Shire Council to do some work on local roads and footpaths. This will include concrete pours to complete footpath links west of the school entry, installing safety fencing, and creating a pedestrian refuge in the existing island west of the roundabout on North Arm Road.

All roads will be open for use during the work and traffic control will be in place to safely manage traffic flow.

Installation of temporary buildings

Two additional temporary buildings will be installed at the school to provide improved spaces for staff and administration. The buildings will be located on the grassed area to the west of the undercover bus waiting area.

Work schedule

Work will start on Wednesday 28 June 2023. Contractors may be on site earlier to establish the construction compound. Temporary fencing will be in place to maintain safety and ensure there is no public access to work areas. School staff will provide extra supervision as required within the school entry and carpark areas.

Working hours

Standard project working hours will be between 7:00am to 5:00pm Monday to Saturday. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays.
