

# Stokers Siding Public School

## Flood Recovery Update

August 2022

Wednesday 31 August 2022

Work to repair and remediate flood-affected spaces and facilities at Stokers Siding Public School is expected to be completed in the next month.

Stokers Siding Public School suffered mould damage to classrooms in Block F, while the General Assistant's shed, paved areas and play spaces were damaged from flood waters in February and March 2022.

Students were able to continue learning at the school from Term 2 in unaffected areas, while repair and remediation works to flood-damaged spaces and facilities were undertaken by the department and contractors.

Students and staff will move back into the repaired classrooms once sink and cupboard areas have been fixed and blinds have been installed on the windows and doors.

Works continuing over the coming weeks include:

- installing the practical activity areas (inc. sinks and cupboards)
- window and door blind installation
- hygienists to monitor condensation levels
- provide additional bark softfall
- flood-affected section of the fixed playground equipment to be replaced.

Delays caused by wet weather, availability of trades and resource shortages have unfortunately resulted in the work taking longer than expected to complete.
