Project Update

What is happening at Condong Public School

A project is underway to rebuild Condong Public School after it was damaged by floods in March 2022. The project will deliver new modern and flexible learning environments and core facilities that will support the long term needs of the local community. The school grounds and gardens, which were damaged during the floods, will be repaired.

Condong Public School students are learning from Murwillumbah South Infants School while their school is being rebuilt.

Current status

- A project team has been appointed.
- An architect was appointed in August and architectural master planning is underway.
- Experts have visited the school and provided recommendations around issues such as flooding and heritage that will help inform the final design of the new school buildings and surrounding area. This includes geo-technical and planning advice.

Next steps

- A managing contract – for a building company that will be responsible for overseeing all the rebuild work – is expected to be awarded in October, with construction works to start in 2023. They will work with the project team to manage the rebuild of Condong Public School.
- School infrastructure NSW will work with Condong Public School to finalise the design of the new school buildings and surrounding areas. A second information session for the Condong Public School community will be held later this year.
- Specialist and technical consultants will continue to visit the site during the planning and construction phases.

Rebuilding Condong Public School is expected to take between 18 months and 2 years, although we will do whatever we can to complete the project sooner.
