Mould remediation

From Monday, August 29, contractors will begin mould remediation work in the Mullumbimby Public School administration building and ground floor K-1 classroom. Both buildings were damaged by floods in March.

Specialists will be carrying out mould remediation inside flood damaged buildings and will be wearing the protective equipment recommended by the occupational hygienist who has assessed the Mullumbimby Public School site.

The work will include treating mould in the flood affected administration building and classroom, and removing mould contaminated material, including wall linings. The work is expected to take a number of weeks.

There will be no risk to students, staff or visitors as a result of the work.

In consultation with the school, site fencing is being erected around the administration building and to block off the ground floor classroom. during the week commencing August 22.

Affected areas will remain out of bounds and only accessible by approved project team members.

Contractors undertaking the work will enter and leave the school from a designated entry point and will be timed to minimise disruption to Mullumbimby Public School students, staff and visitors.
