## School holiday works notification | Autumn 2026

Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours,

### Planned work over the upcoming holidays

The school holidays are the ideal time for a lot of maintenance and project work to take place in schools across the state without disrupting learning.

During the upcoming autumn holiday period, we will be refurbishing the entrance to Building A at Rozelle Public School. This follows on from the removal of the cracked retaining wall and planter box on the northern side of Building A as outlined in the [December 2025](#) update.

The works will be completed over 2 stages and will include 2 sets of stairs on either side of a tiered seating space. This refurbishment will begin in the autumn school holidays and is due to be finished by mid-Term 2, 2026.

During Stages 1 and 2 of the entry area refurbishment, parts of Building A will be isolated from students and staff within a construction zone. Alternative access points will be in place for Building A during this time.

### Stage 1

Stage 1 works will begin in the autumn school holidays and are due to be finished by the end of Week 1 Term 2, 2026. This stage includes removal of the existing northern stairs and construction of new stairs and the tiered seating section. An exclusion zone will be set up in sections of Building A to isolate the construction area.

The Out of School Hours (OOSH) and vacation care service which operates out of Building F will operate as usual during the autumn school holidays. OOSH families can continue to use the existing vacation care entrance and exit as usual.

### Stage 2

Stage 2 works will start from Week 2 Term 2 2026 and includes the removal and construction of the southern set of stairs. During this time an exclusion zone will be set up to isolate the construction area and temporary access to Building A will be in place.
