Works notification | 22 June 2026

Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours,

On [3 June 2026](#) we notified you about our project to upgrade the stormwater and drainage system at Rozelle Public School. As part of this work, we recently engaged an arborist to inspect trees at the school for their health and safety.

While most of the trees at the school were found to be in good health, 4 trees located near the soccer playing field were assessed as a safety risk to the school community and recommended for removal.

Work to safely remove the trees took place on Saturday 20 June 2026.

The NSW Department of Education manages trees on school sites in accordance with local council regulations, our departmental guidelines and advice from qualified arborists.

We appreciate these trees mean a great deal to the community. The arborist's advice means the department had no alternative but to act. Our duty of care to our students, staff and neighbours means responding to safety concerns when they are identified.

We will be planting replacement trees as part of our ongoing commitment to the area and will continue to monitor the space to support the local environment as it recovers and renews.
